






Introduction to Computer Basics



Start Up

To turn on your computer, find and press its power button.

If you have pressed your power button but the computer has not begun its startup sequence, ensure it is:

- Plugged in (or its battery is charged if it is a Laptop)
- Connected to the monitor, and that the monitor is plugged in and turned on

After your computer has powered on, follow the prompts on-screen to either create an account or log in to an existing account.

Desktop Layout

Once your computer has powered on and you have logged in to your account, your computer will display your desktop.

Desktop: Your computer's large background, or "home screen." Think of your desktop like a tabletop, upon which you can place your files and organize your belongings.

On a new computer, the desktop is largely blank, but it can be highly customized to suit your personal tastes, filled with files and shortcuts for easy access, and its background image can be changed.








Navigation

To navigate around your computer, drag your mouse cursor via your mouse or trackpad over the icon you would like to explore and double-click (clicking twice rapidly) the left mouse button. Doing so will open the application or folder you clicked on.



Tip: Your mouse typically has three parts. A left button, right button, and a scroll wheel. Typically, the left mouse button is used to select, the right button is used to open an information menu, and the scroll wheel is used to scroll through screens.






Folders

Your computer uses folders to file and organize for your applications, files, and anything else stored on your computer. Windows comes with pre-existing folders, including the system folders named:

- Desktop, which contains all the files and folders you place on your desktop
- Downloads, which contains all the files you download from the internet
- Documents, which is typically where you will store your files and documents
- Pictures, Music, and Videos, which are typically used to store these file types separately







Internet Browsers

Organizing Your Computer

Once you've become comfortable with your computer, you may occasionally find your work slowed by unorganized files. Take some time to clean up your computer and you wont regret it.

One great way to start organizing your computer is to use folders. Like file folders in real life, folders on your computer can even be nested (placed inside other folders) to group similar folders together.

 Your widgets menu, which can be customized to display weather information, internet connectivity information, the time and date, and other widgets








Desktop

As discussed earlier, you can customize your desktop and folders to more easily access your files, documents, folders, and applications.

Below is an example of a poorly optimized desktop vs a well optimized one.







Updating Your Computer

Users are recommended to regularly update Windows. Windows' updates contain security improvements and keep your applications and systems running quickly and securely.

To update your computer:

- 1. Search "update" in the search bar next to the Windows button
- 2. Click "Check for Updates"
- 3. If the update is downloaded and ready to go, click "Restart now" if you are ready to restart. If not, click "download"

Tip: You must restart your computer to install the new updates. Make sure you save all your work before restarting; otherwise, it may be lost. Your computer will also notify you of existing updates. Follow your computer's prompts to install pending updates.
